Citywide Coordination and Advocacy</b></li> <li><b>Primary role/authority/responsibility:</b> Coordinate and facilitate all the local NAT tables to create a citywide vision and support advocacy to achieve that vision <ul> <li>Facilitated by a city-wide organization</li> <li>Convenes neighborhood tables across the city</li> <li>Identifies common challenges or opportunities coming from the neighborhood tables</li> <li>Generates strategy to prioritize the common issues and turn it into a framework for advocacy, as determined by the NAT tables (A 'Neighborhoods Agenda'),</li> <li>Connects with other organizations working on issues identified by the tables</li> <li>Ongoing support to move the work identified forward</li> <li>Provides administrative support and facilitation for the citywide table</li> <li>Supports citywide advocacy activity</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<ul> <li>2. Neighborhood Action Teams (NAT)</li> <li>Primary role/authority/responsibility: create a vision and priorities for the local neighborhood and work together as a community to carry out that vision.</li> <li>Connects different people and organizations in a community to create priorities and vision for that community</li> <li>Supports the vision of residents and works together to implement that vision through planning, advocacy and other activities</li> <li>Brings different sectors together (human service, business, religious, etc.)</li> <li>Co-create a shared work plan/vision with the community based on shared values and a robust community engagement process</li> <li>Works through lens of racial equity</li> <li>Intentionally connects internal and external partners to drive the work forward</li> <li>Sets budgets and expenditures for the table         <ul> <li>Open to all but the members decide on a process and criteria for joining the table to assure great participation                  -Organizes meetings (finds space, sends emails and agendas)                  -Keeps records - minutes and tracking action items</li> </ul> </li> <li>Membership: residents, CDOs, social service organizations, city staff, local schools, faith-based institutions, academic partners, business groups, and other local stakeholders</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>3. Technical Assistance and Coaching by a Citywide Organization</li> <li>Primary role/authority/responsibility: support, training and coaching to assure that the NAT tables and the citywide table are successful in achieving their vision.</li> <li>Facilitated by a citywide organization</li> <li>Provides training in facilitation skills to the CDO/Facilitators</li> <li>Provides training in various forms of organizing, advocacy, negotiation to support the NAT tables</li> <li>Provides high quality coaching and technical assistance to the CDO facilitator and individual NAT tables to help each table develop their own norms and processes and values</li> <li>Education and capacity building around the need to work together to strengthen the community</li> <li>Supports planning &amp; creating the local NAT tables</li> <li>Assists the CDO/Facilitator and NAT tables in identifying shared values, vision for their work, action plans and key partnership opportunities</li> <li>Supports the CDO/Facilitator and NAT tables in doing ecosystem mapping</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>4. Community Planning and Advocacy</li> <li>Neighborhood Convener/Facilitator</li> <li>Primary role/authority/responsibility: facilitating, coordinating, administering and supporting the NAT tables, at their discretion</li> <li>Facilitated by Neighborhood-based CDO</li> <li>CDO serves as Trustee to the Neighborhood Action Team:         <ul> <li>-Facilitates meetings</li> <li>-Assists the NATs in developing strategic connections</li> <li>-Supports NATs to develop shared vision</li> <li>-Ensures the NATs work from a racial equity lens</li> <li>-Receives funding to facilitate the table and perform administrative functions; and expends budget at the direction of the NATs</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
