 - ✓ What is the distinctive/defining role of CDOs? Why or why not is that role important? Should a CDO play other roles?
 - ✓ What is the role of a Grass Roots Organization?
- How should decisions be made on community development strategies for neighborhood revitalization?

HOW DO WE REVITALIZE NEIGHBORHOODS IN DETROIT?

- Do we revitalize neighborhoods primarily through:
 - ✓ efforts initiated by philanthropy, government or business that are targeted to select areas with "rising" markets; or
 - √ building up communities wherever neighbors are already organized; or
 - ✓ place-making to generate community gathering places and attract visitors?
- Is there value-add in resident engagement and empowerment in the community development process? What is resident engagement vs resident empowerment?
- Detroit has huge swaths of vacant land and property should we exploit this situation and plan for more open/green space in Detroit as a permanent strategy for Detroit's comeback, or should green space be considered a temporary, "holding" strategy until Detroit repopulates?
- What is our economic development theory to be applied to our neighborhoods to make them economically viable?
